RESOLUTION # - 2018 - TO AUTHORIZE NOTICE AND ACCEPTANCE OF SEALED BIDS FOR PHASE III-B OF MORGAN'S DOCK

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the Village of Manorhaven is ready to begin Phase III-B of the Rehabilitation of Historic Morgan's Dock project; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees will receive sealed bids for Phase III-B of the project at Manorhaven Village Hall on **Tuesday, November 27, at 10 a.m.** at which time they will be publicly opened and read with a contract to be awarded as soon thereafter as practicable; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:

- a. all bids shall be in accordance with the specifications, drawings, and terms of the proposed contracts; and
- b. no bids shall be received unless in writing on forms furnished by the Village and unless accompanied by a certified check or bid bond made payable to the Village of Manorhaven in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid; and
- c. the Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality therein; and
- d. the Village will not accept bids from, or award contracts to, anyone who cannot prove to the complete satisfaction of the Board of Trustees that he/she has sufficient experience in this type of work and is financially able and organized to successfully carry out the work required in the specific time period; and
- e. plans and specifications will be available and may be obtained at the Village Hall, 33 Manorhaven Blvd, Port Washington, NY, starting **November 5, 2018** and thereafter, during normal Village business hours; and
- f. a non-refundable fee of \$100.00 is required for each CD of the contract documents; and
- g. this information shall be posted and noticed in Manorhaven's designated locations and local newspapers effective immediately.
