MAYOR COMMENTS:

- Perpetrator Arrested – Recent break-ins on Norwood Rd. and Dunes Lane, and attempted car-breaks in took place for the past two weeks in Manorhaven. The Village has been working with the Nassau County Police and Inspector Abbruzzo to address these and other types of mischievous behavior. We are happy to report that five arrests were made related to the noted break-ins, drugs and alcohol charges.
- Residents Forward has volunteered to help Manorhaven with a clean-up and planting on October 27. The Mayor is proud that we have joined forces with another local community organization for the betterment of Manorhaven.
- Empire National Bank – Deposit Placement Program. Board will vote on a resolution to name Empire National Bank as a depository institution for Manorhaven.
- Connecting the Baywalk – Ken and Priscilla have been working on various portions of the Preserve. Ken, the connecting walkway between Manorhaven and Port North and Priscilla the driveway leading into the Preserve Gardens and Dog Park.
- Grassroots Environmental Education – Patty Wood, guest speaker on 10/25 to discuss cell nodes.

UPCOMING LOCAL LAWS

10/25/2018 - Increase in Parking Fines:

1. Increase from \$40 to \$60 per offense.
2. Increase in fine for shoveling snow into roadways.
