Re: Water Availability

Dear Mayor Avena:

As you are aware a "Letter of Water Availability" must be obtained from Port Washington Water District prior to a municipality issuing a building permit. For large projects that are being planned within your jurisdiction, we strongly recommend that you have the developer / property owner engage the Water District as early as possible in the planning process. This is very important as we proactively address saltwater intrusion concerns and impacts to our operations attributed to additional water demand. Projects will be evaluated against current salt water intrusion limitations, conservation measures and an order by NYSDEC to reduce pumpage by 15%.

Modifications may be required to our infrastructure and operations in order to provide potable water. Such improvements will be at the cost of the developer / property owner. Therefore, early engagement in the process with the Water District will help to mitigate any potential project delays.
