RESOLUTION NO. 48 – MARCH 22, 2023 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF MANORHAVEN TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH CAMERON ENGINEERING AND ASSOCIATES LLP

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees has received a proposal from Cameron Engineering & Associates, LLP (Cameron Engineering) to provide a proposal for Engineering Services to assist the Village of Manorhaven in review of the proposed sanitary sewer application by the Soundview Market Place; and

WHEREAS, the Soundview Market Place is proposing to construct a 5,000 -sf restaurant and would like to connect to the Village's 8-inch diameter on Shore Road, and the Village would like Cameron Engineering to assist in evaluating the physical condition and capacity of the Village's existing sewer system to accommodate the anticipated sewer discharge from the property; and
