

GARBAGE & RECYCLING SCHEDULES

GARBAGE COLLECTION TIMES

Collection begins at 6:00 a.m. on the scheduled pick-up days.

Please place trash receptacles on curbs any time after 5:00 p.m. the day before a pick-up.

Trash receptacles must be put away by **12:00 Midnight** on the day of your scheduled pick up. Loose plastic garbage bags of trash left outside of containers **WILL NOT** be picked up.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE TIMES AND PROCEDURES WILL RESULT IN A TICKET.



NUMBER OF TRASH CONTAINERS PER HOUSEHOLD UNIT

One Family Home: Up to 3 trash receptacles.

Two Family Home: Up to 3 trash receptacles per unit.



ACCEPTABLE BINS FOR GARBAGE

Bins size up to 32 gallons.

Bins over 32 gallons will not be collected.

All bins must be watertight, metal or plastic containers WITH a lid.



BULK PICK-UPS

All large items MUST BE called into Dejana for a pick-up date (normally Thursday and Friday).



DUMPSTERS

Residents must apply to the Village Building Department for a permit.

CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL AND HAZARDOUS WASTE IS NOT PERMITTED!

(paint, chemicals, toilets, sinks, motor oil, car batteries, tires, etc.)

RECYCLABLES

New Recycling Rules Effective as per The Town of North Hempstead!

Recycle bins or cans should be BLUE IN COLOR and may be purchased at Village Hall.

DEPENDING ON YOUR GARBAGE PICK-UP DAYS:

The following recyclables will be picked up Monday or Tuesday (One Day ONLY)

- Cardboard Must be broken down and bundled!
- Paper Can be bundled or put out in paper bags only; Leave alongside garbage cans.

The following will be picked up on Thursday or Friday (One Day ONLY)*

- •Glass •Metal Cans need to be washed out and labels removed.
- Plastics Only plastic #1 and #2 will be taken; All other plastic goes in regular garbage!



*Glass, metal and plastics can be placed loose in the recycle bin or in CLEAR bags only.

ELECTRONIC ITEMS

No electronics may be disposed of with regular garbage on ANY pick-up day. No televisions, microwaves, stereos, computers, printers, etc.

S.T.O.P. (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) Events are held by the Town of North Hempstead throughout the year to dispose of electronics and a full schedule was mailed to residents and included in our Winter Newsletter.



YARD WASTE

Yard waste collection is **every Wednesday** (excluding holidays) from the **first Wednesday in April** through the **last Wednesday in December**.

For Loose Grass or Leaves: Containers, paper bags, or plastic bags are now accepted with yard waste. To avoid getting a ticket, use three containers max or six bags, max. Sticks, twigs and branches must be tied into manageable bundles.

MONDAY AND THURSDAY

All of Manhasset Isle, including: Tom's Point; Manorhaven Blvd. including businesses and apartments from Sands Point Road to Firwood: Ashwood through Edgewood Road including Sands Point Road and Cambridge Avenue from Sands Point to Firwood and Ford Place; South Orchard Beach area including Linwood South: Marwood South; Kaywood; Norwood South; Oldwood South; West Drive; Arcadia; and Orchard Beach Blvd.



TUESDAY AND FRIDAY

Firwood through Kirkwood, including: Cambridge Avenue from Firwood through Kirkwood; Linwood North: Marwood North; Cornwell's Lane; Dunes Lane; Cornwall; and Manorhaven Blvd. including businesses and apartments from Firwood to Oldwood



HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

No pick-up on the following days:

- •New Year's Day
- President's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Columbus Day
- Thanksgiving
- Christmas

On legal holidays, trash will be picked up the following day. Garbage cannot be placed at the curb earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the night before a pick-up day and must be put away by 12:00 Midnight the day of pick-up to avoid a ticket.



RESIDENTIAL/CURBSIDE RECYCLING INFORMATION

HOW TO PREPARE FOR RECYCLING	WHAT IS NOT RECYCLABLE
